BOCZYSKO I

The Competition Rules

1. The word “BOCZYSKO” is a tongue-in-cheek Polish translation of the term BROADSIDE, coined by the poet MLB (Miłosz Biedrzycki).
2. A broadside is a work printed on one side, consisting of a literary text and an illustration, and executed in at least 5 numbered copies. The graphic layout of the text can be regarded as the broadside’s illustration. A broadside should include a colophon describing the technical details of the print such as title, author, kind of paper used, printing techniques, fonts, etc., as well as the number of the copy and the author’s signature, both marked in pencil.
3. The broadsides can be executed using various techniques such as letterpress, intaglio, lithography, silkscreen printing, etc. Works made exclusively by digital printing are not eligible.
4. Broadside that are also signed by the text’s author (if different than the author of the broadside) and/or translator will receive special consideration.
5. The broadside’s author is responsible for complying with the applicable copyrights.
6. The award pool of 1,500 PLN will be awarded by the competition jury to the winning broadside(s).
7. Selected broadsides may be accepted on consignment by The Gallery of Beautiful Books.
8. The deadline for submitting entries is November 15, 2016. Authors can submit multiple entries. To participate in the competition please fill out the entry form for each entry, and submit it with five hard copies of the broadside to: The Gallery of Beautiful Books, 96 Pańska #203, 00837 Warsaw, Poland.
